David Easton is one of the world's most sought after interior designers. After graduating from the Pratt Institute in 1963, he received the Fontainebleau scholarship. Easton returned to the U.S. to work for the venerable firm of Edward Wormley, where he designed for Dunbar Furniture. He went on to join Parish-Hadley Associates before starting his own firm, David Easton Incorporated, in 1972. While he made his name as a neo-classicist, Easton has shifted to a more streamlined, contemporary aesthetic in response to his own changing tastes and those of his clients. Easton was named to the Interior Design Hall of Fame in 1992, and his peers recently honored him with the Lifetime Achievement Award at London's Design and Decoration Awards. In 2010, Easton was named to *Architectural Digest's* Top 100 Designers for the ninth time. *Reservations required.*
